Emmett Till
was a
14-year old
African
American boy
who was
murdered in
August 1955.

Emmett was a Chicago, native and was visiting family in Money Mississippi, when accused of harassing a white women.

A few days later, family members of the woman kidnaped Till, brutally beating and killing him before dumping his body in a river nearby.





In September of 1955 an all-white jury found Bryant not guilty of Till's kidnapping and murder. Emmett's
