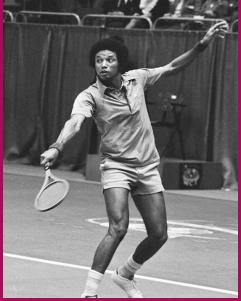


Arthur was an American professional tennis player who won three grand slam singles titles.

Earlier in the year the assassinations of Martin Luther King, and Robert Kennedy had shocked Ashe out of his youthfulness to become involved in the struggle for Civil Rights, over the next 25 years he worked tirelessly as an advocate for civil and human rights, a role model to athletes.

The impact that Arthur had was he campaigned against the apartheid regime in South Africa. By using tennis to inspire social change. Throughout his life, he worked to help address issues of racism and poverty around the world.
